Chairman's Welcome

By the time you read these words the annual Town Festival will be upon us, and yet again the committee has worked all year to make 2009 even better than before. Despite the economic crisis the level of interest, support and donations has surprised us all, thank you to everyone.

This year follows the successful format of previous years with a number of events and new attractions over Festival Week.

The opening parade on Saturday 4th July includes a marching band, a range of classic cars, dancing schools and of course local schools and organisations in fancy dress following this year's theme "SPLASH". Some of the arena events include displays of dancing, gymnastics, martial arts, marching band, drumming, a 7 a side football tournament and for the first time, a tug-of-war competition.

For the children there will be a bouncy castle, climbing wall, Punch and Judy, face painting and much more. For mums and dads a bar and refreshments will be available from the start.

The day continues when we welcome back the Sound Force Big Band who will provide a free evening of "Music in the Park". Bring along a picnic and dance the night away.

A **10km run on Sunday 5th July**, starting and finishing in the Market Square this event now attracts over 400 runners.

From 4th – 10th **July inc.** many local organisations will be holding special events and open days to promote themselves and you are encouraged to go along to enjoy and even participate. These include the angelic voices of **local school choirs** who perform daily in St Mary's church, plus open days at the Paddocks Clinic, Post Office, Hypnos, Ercol, and a fashion show at the British Legion.

The Festival week culminates over the weekend of **11th /12th July** with the **Street Fayre on Saturday** with an array of stalls, rides and music for all ages. A Town Council sponsored **Pig Roast** in the Market Square supported by a local band wraps up the day. The final event on the last Sunday is a children's **chocolate hunt** at Whiteleaf Cross.

Let's hope for a week of summer weather, fingers crossed that our theme this year "SPLASH" is not a bad omen.

Please come along to as many events as possible to support your local businesses, organisations and entertainers. Economic crisis or not entry to most events is free; however a donation would not go amiss to help us support the Festival Charity which is '**Risborough Cares**'.

My year as Chairman has been challenging but great fun. The Festival Committee have worked incredibly hard to bring new ideas and events to make 2009 even bigger and better. I do hope therefore you will come along and support the town and organisations to make it a Festival to remember.

A gymnastics display by Booker Gym Club will demonstrate fun on the tumble, tumbling and floor routines to music.

The display by Kuzushi Judo Club will include throws, self-defence and restraint and will also introduce us to the Olympic sport of Judo.

The main arena will be surrounded by many other attractions including a climbing wall, face painting, bouncy castle, Punch & Judy, musical activities for children up to 8 years lead by Bambini's, Bar-B-Q by the Explorer Scouts and the Guides will have their usual stall of games and a host of other fun activities.

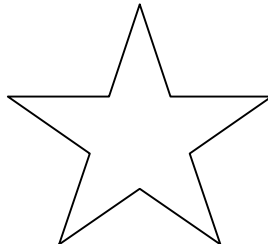
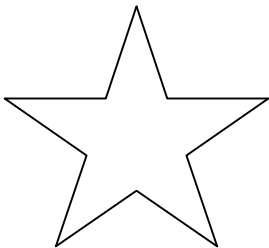
