**2. MINUTES**

The Minutes of the previous meeting of the Town Council meeting having been circulated were approved by the Meeting and signed by the Chairman.

**3. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

Members were asked to declare any personal interest and the nature of that interest which they may have in any of the items under consideration at this meeting.

Cllrs C Etholen, B Bendyshe-Brown, R Orsler declared an interest as members of RACA.

Cllr L A Benifer declared an interest as an observer of the RACA meetings.

**4. THE ACTION TO TAKE IN RELATION TO A CONFLICT OF INTEREST BETWEEN RACA AND PRTC**

Cllr A Turner proposed that the Town Council request a meeting with the Chief Executives of B.C.C. and W.D.C. Ms V Letheren, Cabinet Member and Chair of Transportation, B.C.C. and the Leader of the W.D.C., Lesley Clarke first and then a separate meeting with RABG, RARA and RACA. Seconded by Cllr E Clifford.

Cllr B Bendyshe-Brown proposed an amendment to the proposal that the Town Council meet with the RABG, RARA and RACA first and then following that meeting, if there is no clear consensus of opinion, meet with County and District. Seconded by Cllr C Etholen.

A vote was taken on the amendment and was rejected with 6 councillors against, 3 for and 1 abstention.

A vote was then taken on the original proposal and was accepted with a majority of 6 councillors for the motion, 3 against and 1 abstention.

**5. ON THE RECOMMENDATION FROM THE MEMORIAL GARDEN TO AMEND THE EXISTING REGULATION NUMBER 6C**

**All present agreed** to the recommendation of the Memorial Garden Committee to amend existing Regulation 6c to state that flowers may only be placed on the graves on Mother's Day, Fathers Day and the week prior to and after Christmas Day. Flowers for children's graves may only be placed on Birthdays and the week prior to after Christmas Day.
