1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies were received and accepted by Cllrs P Williams, B Bendyshe-Brown, LA Benifer and W Streule.

2. MINUTES

The Minutes of the previous meeting of the Town Council on 22nd February 2011, having been circulated were approved by the Meeting and signed by the Chairman.

3. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

4. THE TOWN COUNCIL'S CONTRIBUTION TOWARDS THE MARKET EXPANSION PROJECT

Cllr Turner as Town Council representative on the Market Management Group, informed the members of the current situation concerning the Market Expansion /Sunday Markets Project. He confirmed that they were in receipt of a grant offer from Leader for £12,186.23 for the purposes of the Market Expansion/Sunday Market project. Cllr Hall proposed that the Town Council provide the £3500.00 to secure the grant offer, seconded by Cllr Coombs, **agreed by all present.**

Cllr Orsler - Chairman of Finance proposed that the requested amount is allocated from the existing reserves fund. **All present agreed** to this proposal. Cllr Orsler requested a latest balance sheet from the Market Traders, Cllr Turner agreed to source this information. **AT**

5. ON ACCEPTING THE LEADER FUNDING OFFER

All present agreed to accept the funding offer from Leader through the Town Council.

6. ON CONTACTING RACA TO ESTABLISH THEIR VIEWS WITH REGARD TO THE AMT RETAIL REVIVAL TOWN CENTRE PROJECT

Cllr Turner proposed that the Town Council formally contact RACA to ascertain their views on the recent AMT Retail Revival Town Centre project. It was proposed that Cllr Turner construct the letter to be sent on behalf of the Town Council. A vote was taken, 8 for and 1 abstention. The motion was therefore carried. **AT**
